

ENGINEER/SURVEYOR OF COUNSEL

Definition:

The Engineer/Surveyor of Counsel acts as a technical expert or advisor for the company, providing specific engineering/surveying expertise on a job to job basis. May work to market the company and counsel management regarding policies, procedures, goals, and mission of the company.

Duties:

- Senior project management.
- Oversee the preparation of calculations, plans, maps, details and specifications.
- Perform marketing.
- Maintain and promote professional and community involvement.
- Meet with clients, contractors, agencies, and others.
- Mentor employees.
- Assist and/or advise Managing (Principal) Engineers/Surveyors and Owners.
- Provide expert witness testimony.
- Publish articles.

Qualifications:

Experience/Education: Ten years as a SENIOR or PRINCIPAL ENGINEER or SURVEYOR and fifteen years as an employee of the company. Must demonstrate strong commitment to company policies and to employee and client relationships. A demonstrated record of successful project completion, including budget control and client satisfaction, is required, as is the ability to work within a team environment. Must demonstrate a strong ability to supervise and lead others. Must have a demonstrated marketing record. Must have specific expertise in engineering/surveying specialties.

Additional: Some local and/or out of town travel may be required. Possession of a valid California Driver License and clean DMV report.
